

Christ the Way of Life

What does Jesus declare Himself to be?

“Jesus saith unto him, *I am the way, the truth, and the life*: no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me.” **John 14:6**.

In what condition are all man?

“But the Scripture hath concluded all *under sin*.” Gal. 3:22. “For *all have sinned*, and come short of the glory of God.” **Rom. 3:23**.

What are the wages of sin?

“The wages of sin is *death*.” **Rom. 6:23**.

People need to understand this simple truth that is mentioned in John 14:6, Gal 3:22, Rom 3:23, and Rom 6:23. A lot of people today listen to the pastors of their church, who allow their congregation to believe they are saved from sin by just saying they are a Christian or just walking into a Christian Church on Sunday just praising the Lord to be forgiven of their sin. Which, by allowing the people to continue in this way of thinking it leaves avenues open for the people to go back into sin or continue the sin they were engaging in already, most people believe by doing that which the Pope says, they will help them gain entrance into the kingdom of Heaven. In the past the Popes have said they were the bridge maker between heaven and earth which is false to say.

But we see that in John 14:6, Jesus says that that no man come unto the father but by him, meaning it is only through Jesus we are able to make it into God’s kingdom not the Pope.

All people today are short of the glory of God as mentioned in **Gal 3:22** and **Rom 3:23**, mankind today do not deserve the kindness and mercy of the Lord, because of our own constant transgressions of his law every day, which is why we need to strive to walk in that Perfect image of Christ to the best of our ability.

Now what is God’s gift to those who keep his commandments?

“The gift of God is eternal life.” Rom. **6:23**.

“This is the record, that God hath given to us eternal life, and this life is in His Son.” 1 John 5:11.

“He that hath the Son hath *life*.” **1 John 5:12**.

What loss do those sustain who do not accept Christ?

“And he that hath not the Son of God hath not life.” **1 John 5:12**.

In what other way is this same truth stated?

“He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting life: and he that believeth not the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abideth on him.” **John 3:36**.

The Scriptures could not be more clear by saying “**he that hath not the Son of God hath not life.**” mentioned in 1John 5:12. And, whoever does not Believe on Jesus Christ that

“**the wrath of God abideth on him.**” as stated in John 3:36”.

The bible also says “let God be true and every man a liar” **Rom 3:4**.

So if God tells the people to believe on his son Jesus Christ and the people go and worship other deities (Like Buddha, Muhammad, Baal, Satan, the Pope, Allah, etc) that God did not tell them to worship knowing that the bible says this clearly what are they doing?

Well James 4:17 could not be more clear by saying

“Therefore to him that knoweth to do good, and doeth *it* not, to him it is sin.” **James 4:17**.

What about those people who claim to be Christians and do not walk after the ways of Christ or follow the law of God?

James 2:19 & 20 “Thou believest that there is one God; thou doest well: the devils also believe, and tremble. But wilt thou know, O vain man, that faith without works is dead?”

Matthew 7:21 “Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.”



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What does the Bible says about loving family and friends more than Christ?

Christ said in **Mat 10:37-40** "He that loveth father or mother more than me is not worthy of me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me. And he that taketh not his cross, and followeth after me, is not worthy of me. He that findeth his life shall lose it: and he that loseth his life for my sake shall find it. He that receiveth you receiveth me, and he that receiveth me receiveth him that sent me."

Now how we are supposed to pattern our walk with Christ and how can we become more Christ like?

"Then spake Jesus again unto them, saying, I am the light of the world: he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life." **John 8:12.**

"*There is* therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit." **Romans 8:1**

To be more Christ like why does Romans 8:1 say not to walk after the flesh?

"Love not the world, neither the things *that are* in the world. If any man love the

world, the love of the Father is not in him. For all that *is* in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world." **1John 2:15 & 16**

John says it clearly when he stated in 1John 2:15 & 16. To love nothing in the world, also he mentions that the lust of the eyes and lust of the flesh, and the prides of the world are not of the father Jesus also said in

John 10:30 "I and my Father are one."

So basically anything that is not of God is also not of Christ

What else Jesus Christ instructs his people to do, to become more like him?

If ye keep my commandments, ye shall abide in my love; even as I have kept my Father's commandments, and abide in his love. **John 15:10**

Now Jesus tells all man to keep the commandments of God. Why?

"Fear God, and keep His commandments: *for this is the whole duty of man.*" **Eccl. 12:13.**

And, in order to receive the gift of eternal life from God Christ says in Mat 19:17

"If thou wilt enter into life, *keep the commandments.*" **Matt. 19:17.**

By what is the knowledge of sin?

"For *by the law is the knowledge of sin.*" **Rom. 3:20.**

So by keeping the commandment like Jesus said, the people can become aware of the knowledge of sin.

And, try to avoid transgression of the Law because 1John 3:4 could not be more clearly by saying

"Whosoever committeth sin transgresseth also the law: for *sin is the transgression of the law.*" **1 John 3:4.**

remember what Romans 6:23 says

"The wages of sin is *death.*" **Rom. 6:23.**

So by keeping the commandments of God, accepting Christ as Lord, and staying away from lust of the world, the people can become more Christ Like and, live more peaceful lives without sin. For more information please visit
